

Coming from Durham:

Traveling south on Highway 15-501, pass the light for New Hope Commons/Mt. Moriah Road. Then pass over I-40. Turn right at the second stoplight (across from the big Blue Cross Blue Shield Building) which is Eastowne Drive (Eastowne Drive is a semi-circle with a traffic light at each end. It is easier to take the 2nd turn as indicated above). You will pass a service road, an apartment complex and Old Sterling Rd. Then turn left at the next road, which is Providence Road (Providence Road is also a semi-circle.) On the left you will see a large green and gold sign reading "The Atrium". Right after that is Eastowne Hills Executive Offices: make a left turn into the parking lot and you will see Suite 209.

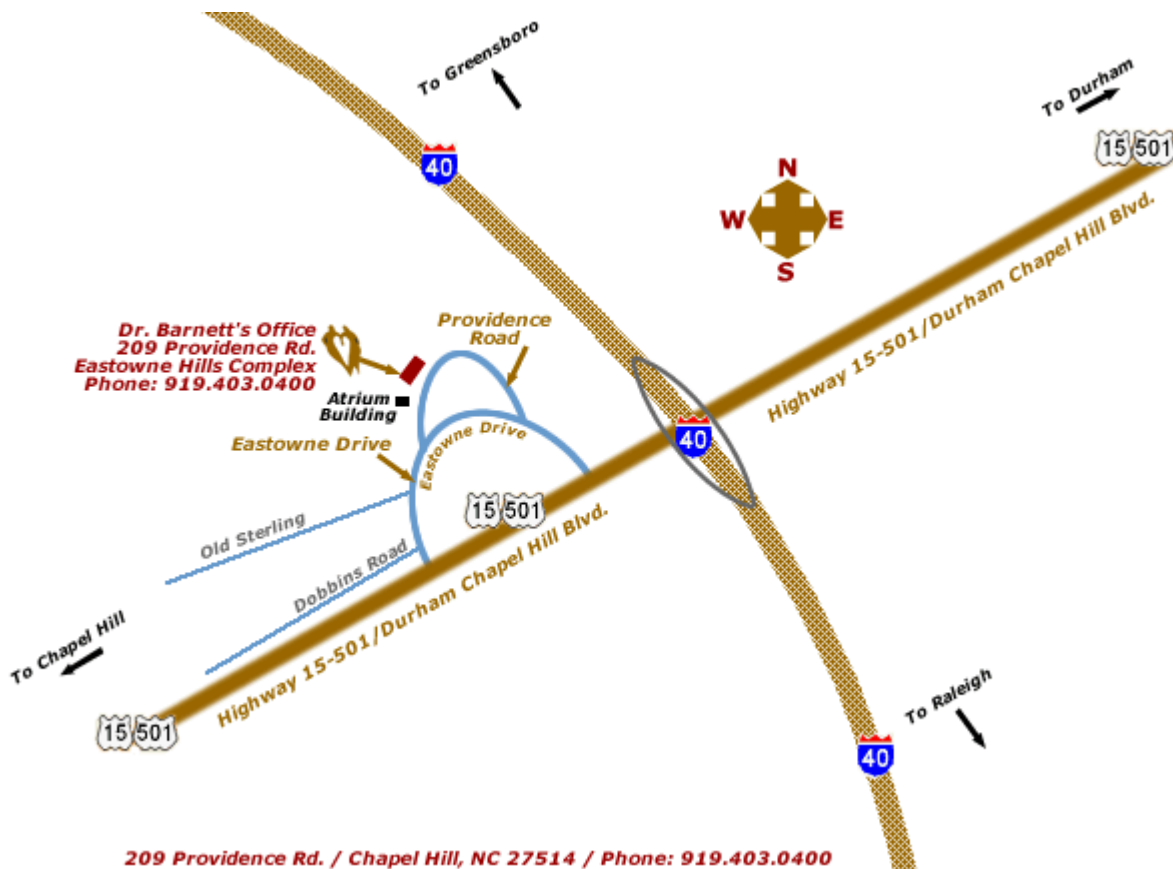
Coming from Chapel Hill:

Traveling north on Highway 15-501, pass the light at Sage Road (Lowe's will be on the left, set back from the road). Get into the left lane. Turn left at the next stoplight, which is Eastowne Drive (Eastowne Drive is a semi-circle with a traffic light at each end. If you miss one, you can go on to the next). You will see the big Blue Cross Blue Shield building on the right at this light). You will pass a service road, an apartment complex and Old Sterling Rd. Then turn left at the next road, which is Providence Road (Providence Road is also a semi-circle.) On the left you will see a large green and gold sign reading "The Atrium". Right after that is Eastowne Hills: make a left turn into the parking lot and you will see Suite 209.

Coming from I-40: Take Exit 270 (15-501 Chapel Hill).

From I-40 East, turn right onto Highway 15-501, then turn right at the second stoplight, which is Eastowne Drive. (Eastowne Drive is a semi-circle with a traffic light at each end). Follow directions above.

From I-40 West, turn left onto Highway 15-501, turn right at the second stoplight, which is Eastowne Drive. (Eastowne Drive is a semi-circle with a traffic light at each end). Follow directions above.
